What another great week in Goodshelter class. We have been very busy this week being super learners.

Reading

The children have received reading books and reading diaries, reading should be completed at least three times a week and recorded, I will check on Friday and give out some special stickers: D

We have started our phonics/ guided reading and English this week. Some have been working with Mrs Brown and some with me. We have both been super impressed with everyone and how quickly they are getting back into it. In guided reading this week we have started our text which is 'Coming to England' by Floella Benjamin, we have read the beginning and been learning all about her life in Trinidad which is very interesting.

Homework

Our new history topic is Post World war 2 and the 50's/60's/70's era, I wonder if you know anyone who was born then? Could you ask them what they remember and write it down?

In Maths we have started our place value block, year 2's have been going up to 100 and year 4's to 1000. We have been using our reasoning skills to explain the answers to the questions.

PE

We have our PE lessons on a Monday and Thursday so they will need their kits in school then

In Science year 2's have been working with Mrs Brown and Start Point to investigate everyday materials, this week they were sorting different objects into their type of material. Year 3's and 4's went on a habitat hunt outside to see how many different habitats they could find. They then had to use their scientific skills to predict which animals they thought lived in those habitats and give evidence. We even found a newt under one of the logs in the adventure playground.

This week we started our PE lessons with Miss Steer which was very exciting. We had a lesson on basic invasion skills and next week we are going to on to some athletic skills.

Apologies for the confusion on forest school and PE this week. Forest and Beach with Pete is returning on the 30th of September which will be every other week. We will have PE every Monday. Next week Miss Wright is going to deliver a Forest School session on Thursday.



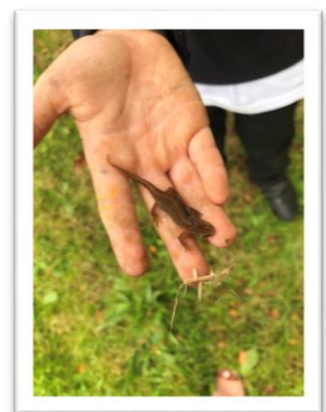
