Year 2's have been representing numbers up to 50 using ten frames, part whole models and place value charts. Year 3 and 4 have been doing the same with numbers up to 1000 so have been using the 100 squares as well. We have also been practicing our number sense by writing our own mathematical stories and calculations.

In History we are really enjoying learning all about the Windrush. This week we found out about some individuals who were on the boat, why they were coming to England. We also talked about their first impressions of England which is that it was very grey and rainy. We have definitely seen some of that this week!

In Science the year 2's have been working with Mrs Brown learning all about magnetism, they created their own magnet boards and had to explain how it worked. We decided they are very fascinating creatures.
