

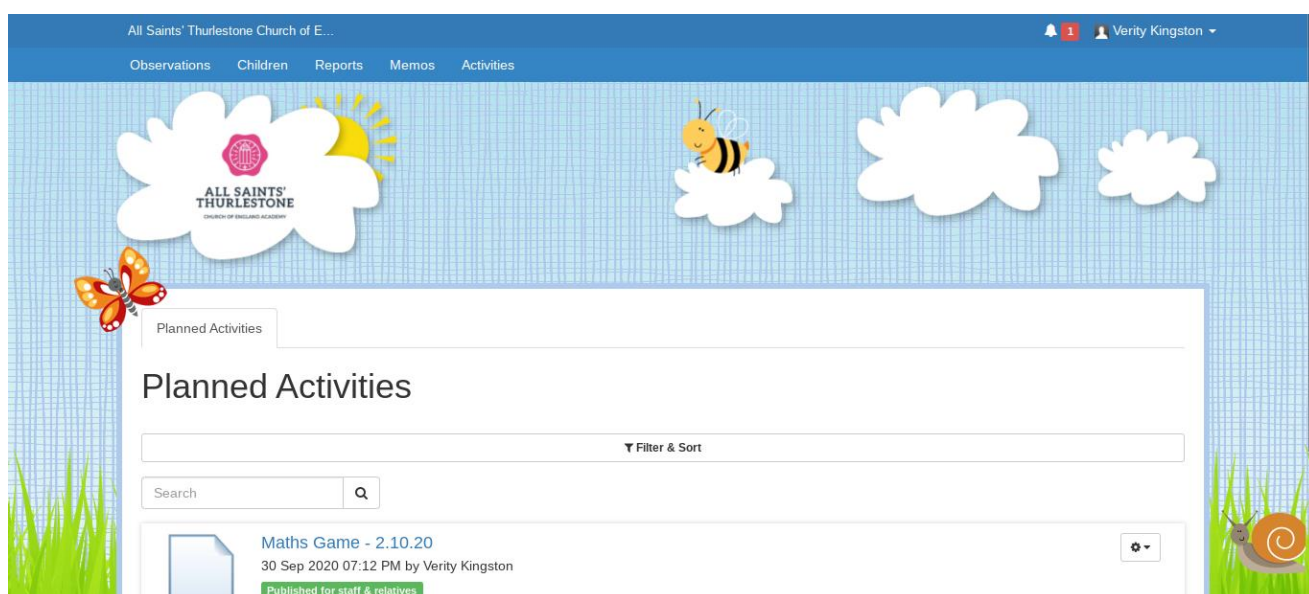
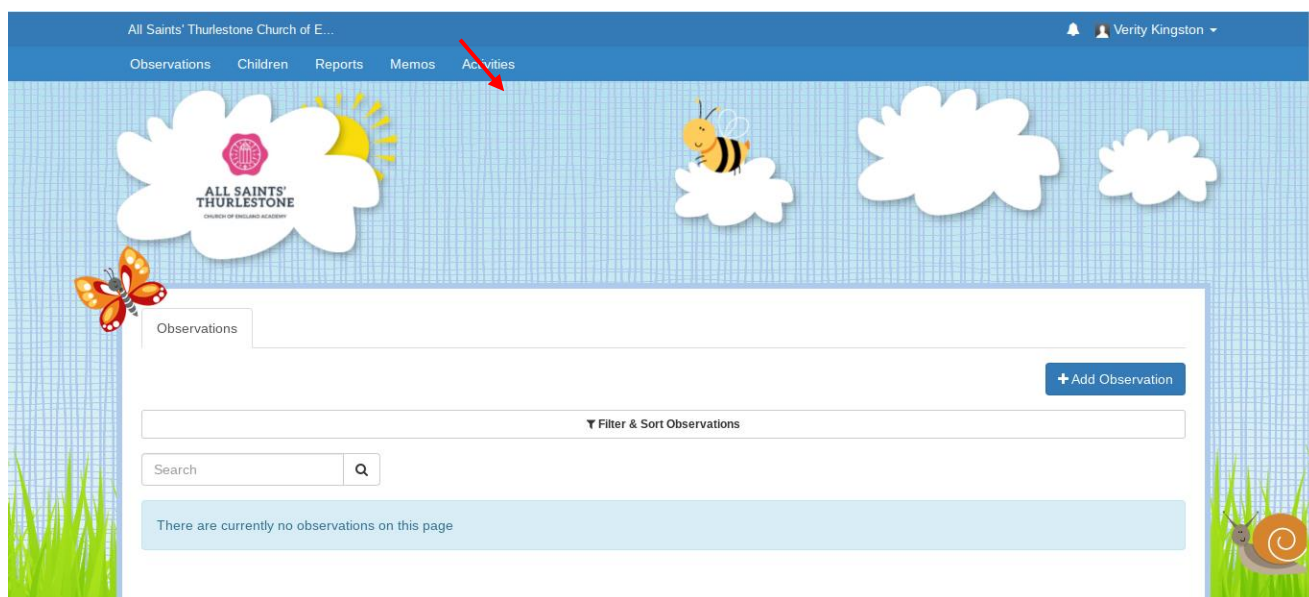
Using Tapestry to find Home Learning

Accessing the Activities
