This week in Geography we used Lego to support us in our learning about rivers. To start with we had to build just a river with the Lego and then label it using what we could remember, for example, the source and the mouth. We then talked about how water falls, meanders and erosion when created and then showed this with our Lego. This really helped to embed the learning and we are now river experts!

In PE this week we continued with our athletics and completed some relay runs. We were in teams and had to complete a certain amount of runs using our proper runners pose. We were all so quick!

In Maths this week we have been extending our place value learning to compare, order and partition numbers. We have been able to explain our learning, linking back to what we have already been looking at in place value. Year 2's have been going up to 100, year 3's have been going up to 1000 and year 4's have been working up to 10,000. We have also been finding more or less using this knowledge as well.

In English we have completed our last skill of this half term before we move on to complete our final piece which is going to be a diary entry. This week we were focusing on subordinate conjunctions and how we use them to link two sentences together, we used this skill to edit some pieces of writing and change them to suit a different audience.

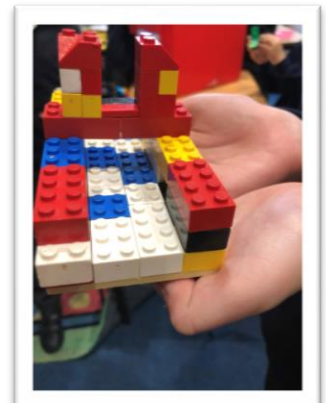
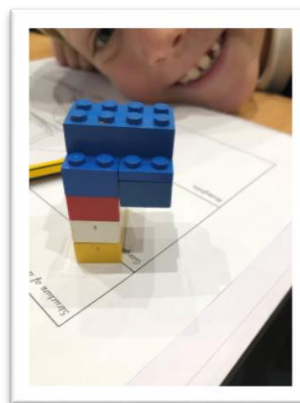
