On Tuesday we were joined by Ed from Fun Science who came to deliver an electricity workshop. In the workshop we made some mini robots using our own circuit, we used our science knowledge to explain what a circuit is, and Ed was very impressed. The Robots had mini motors so they could move across the table, and we even made a switch so they could turn on and off. We then had a go using his Van De Graaf, first we all touched it to see if we felt any static on our fingers which was great fun. We then tried touching it with both of our hands to see what the static would do to our hair, there were some great hairstyles going on!



On Tuesday afternoon the year 3's and 4's also completed a science experiment to do with their topic of States of Matter.
