This Week in Start Point

As Artists we had a great lesson with Mrs Norton continuing our learning about Anthony Goldsworthy. This week we explored the way that spirals are everywhere in nature and art. Spirals are also used by Aboriginal people in their artwork. We explored how Aboriginal people use spirals and had a go at creating our own artwork based on their work.



Year 1

As mathematicians in Year 1 we have been investigating height and length, gathering up all the measuring tapes and rulers in school to practise using scales and reading the numbers correctly. We have also been comparing heights and using lots of Mathematical vocabulary like length, depth, wide, width, short, shorter, shortest, long, longer and longest. Why not try some measuring at home?

As historians this week, we used the family tree that shows the relationships amongst the House of Windsor and used it to understand and plot the line of succession. We explored what the line of succession means and how just before Prince George was born, the Queen changed the law to allow the first-born child, regardless of whether they were female or male, to succeed to the British throne.

In our PE lesson this week with Miss Worden, the children have continued to focus on multi skills. They have been developing their accuracy with different types of throws such as under arm, over arm and chest pass.

We loved the fun for Comic Relief today especially joining an assembly with all of the children across our Trust family and watching the Head Teachers dance!!
