What a lovely sunshiny week we have, finally feels like Spring is here! We have definitely made the most of the sunshine by being out in the adventure playground.

In our maths this week we have started our new block on geometry, we have been focusing on 2D shapes this week. To start off with we learnt the names of all the 2D shapes and how they are also known as polygons, we then had a go at grouping the shapes and sorting them. Year 2 then went on to finding a line of symmetry in the shapes and year 3 finding a right angle, we were impressed with how many right angles there are around us!



In Science this week year 3 have been carrying on their learning about states of matter, this week we were thinking about how matters can change. We carried out an experiment to see how a solid and liquid could turn into a gas, we did this by placing an effervescent tablet in some water and a balloon over the top, the balloon blew up so we discussed how this was happening.

In RE this week we have been thinking about some more symbols of Easter, we thought about hot cross buns and how they symbolise Easter and why- we even got to taste some! We then looked at some pictures of inside a church to see if we could spot any symbols in there. We saw Easter Eggs, psalm leaves and the cross which all represent part of the Easter story.
