We have had a fabulous week full of creative activities and a lovely trip to Buckfast Abbey. It's been brilliant to see our children developing as designers and artists.

This Week in Croft

In design and technology, we have been designing our final piece; a collapsible rain shelter.

Croft had to use their critical thinking skills to think of a structure that is easy to erect should it begin to rain. They have been learning about what will give our structures strength and different kinds of lashing with which to bind their shelter together. They then made a model of their design using straws.



On Tuesday we had a whole school trip to Buckfast Abbey. It has been so long since we were able to go out altogether and everyone was very excited. We were treated to some lovely activities, the first being a tour of the Abbey to make a religious thread signifying the events of Jesus during holy week.

At different points of the abbey, our wonderful guide told us of the entry of Jesus on a donkey into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, his betrayal leading to his crucifixion and his



resurrection. We thought about Jesus as a person, how he helped his followers and his bravery. At each station we added a bead to our thread to remind us of his journey during Holy week. In the Abbey is a magnificent stain glass window depicting Jesus with the bread and wine, which was made by one of the monks who had lived

there. Our second activity was an opportunity to create our own stain glass windows of the cross. We all had such a lovely time.

As artists, we have begun our Henry Moore models ready to cover with Modroc. We created organic forms from newspaper and used tin foil to hold them together. Croft have made some fabulous pieces which really highlight their understanding of Moore and the techniques he used.
