We have had such a fun week back at school to kickstart the Summer Term.

Year 3's and 4's had their first sailing lesson this week which was so much fun. They were able to play lots of games on the beach and in the sea. They also learnt the different parts of the boat and the technical terms for the boat. It was a bit cold, but we soon warmed up from our walk back to Salcombe and getting on the coach. In Geography this week we have started our new unit on the country Greece. We used atlases this week to find Greece, some of us even used the index to find the correct map. We then looked at the population in Greece and compared it to our own.



In RE this week, we have started our new unit on the Pentecost and the impact of the Pentecost. We recapped what happened during the Easter story to begin with and thought about what the Kingdom of God is and how this links to the Easter story. We then learnt the story of the Pentecost and how the Holy Spirit visited the disciples, we thought about how that may have made them feel. Using a graph, we plotted the emotions of the disciples throughout the Easter story and the Pentecost.

We really enjoyed our PE this week, we have started Athletics so this week we learnt some of the main skills needed for Athletics.
