Dear all,

This week we really enjoyed our webinar from the National Art Gallery, we were learning all about colour and light with them. We were joined virtually by an artist from the National Gallery who asked us lots of questions about paintings, in particular, looking at the colour and the light. We then had a go at creating our own colours by mixing and using those to paint.

In English this week we have started our sentence stacking lessons to create our set of instructions together. This week we have been thinking about the hook in instructions and how to set out what you need. We have been using complex sentences, rhetorical questions, and brackets. We also followed our own set of instructions to make a paper boat like Kate does in her book to help her feel relaxed. We had a go at the breathing exercise ourselves and we definitely felt very relaxed!



In Maths this week we have started to look at money, we started off by just identifying different types of money including coins and notes. We then used this to identify different amounts. Year 2's have been making different amounts in different ways using coins, year 3 have been converting money from pounds to pence. Maybe at home you can have a go at spotting some different amounts of money?

In RE this week, we have continued to look at the story of the Pentecost, this week we watched and listened to the story and then thought about some symbols that are present in the story. We matched the symbols to the part of the story and then had a go at retelling the story ourselves using the symbols.
