This Week in Start Point

As mathematicians week, we have been learning about 'volume and capacity', comparing different containers to see how much they can hold, ordering containers by their volume and working out capacity and volume problems. Start Point class have loved measuring with lots of different containers in our outdoor area and classroom.

In PE with Miss Worden, we have continued to work on our athletic skills. This week we have been practising our over arm throw using balls and javelins and practising relay races using batons. Last Friday afternoon practised our fielding and batting skills with Mr V from premier sports. We loved throwing the javelins as far as we could!

As geographers this week, we have continued with our topic about Australia by looking at how the country is split into different regions like our counties. We discussed the size of Australia compared to the UK and began to talk about the similarities and differences between Australia and the UK. Roo brought in a 'didgeridoo' and we all had a go at playing it.

As scientists this week, Year 1 had to explain why something was living, remembering the 7 life processes that define a living thing. We've had great fun investigating the living creatures and plants around us in school.
