We are in July already, the weeks are racing away! On Thursday we had a shuffle up day and the children got to meet their new teacher. There has been lots of great learning in Start Point this week

As mathematicians, we have been learning about geometry by making left and right turns, clockwise and anti clockwise, 1 quarter, half 3 quarter and full turns. We have also been learning about position; in front of, forwards, backwards, behind, next to, inside and to the right and left. We are also continuing to count in 2's, 5's and 10's.

In PE with Miss Worden, we have started to play games of rounders and to practise our throwing and catching skills.

As scientists this week, Year 1 we learned about the famous naturalist David Attenborough. We watched some clips from different documentaries. We then went out in Adventure to film our own nature documentaries.
