As scientists this week year 1 and 2 carried out an experiment all about how exercise increases your heart rate. They had to find their pulse and then use this to work out which activity increased their heart rate the most. This was teaching us all about why exercise is good for us.




As designers this week we were taste testing our fruit and vegetables to see which ones we want to include on our fruit kebab. We tasted carrot, apple, banana, melon and cucumber, after tasting them we then had to describe them using technological words. Finally, we rated them out of 10.

As geographers this week we have carried on our learning on the climate in Kenya and the Uk to now looking at the weather. We thought about the weather that we get in the Uk and compared it to what happens in Kenya. We noticed that it gets a lot hotter in Kenya!
