As artists this week we have been looking at the work of Kandinsky and how he uses colour. We looked at how colours have different names and how primary colours can be mixed to make other colours. We had a go at doing our own colour mixing and making a colour wheel in our books. We then thought about how the different colours make us feel, for example, red being an angry colour and yellow being a happy colour.

As musicians this week we used our glockenspiels to play along to the music we have been learning. We have been learning a rock song called rock pool rock so we learnt some notes so we could play along to this.



As global citizens this week we have been thinking about the story of 'the rainbow fish' and what this teaches people. We then thought of some stories in the bible that teaches Christians to look after everyone and to be kind. After this, we learnt a whole new song about being kind and sang it together.

As mathematicians this week year 1 have started to look at fractions and what a half is, how we identify a half and how we can make a half. We have been looking at colouring in shapes so they can be split in half.
