We have had great fun exploring our new classroom!

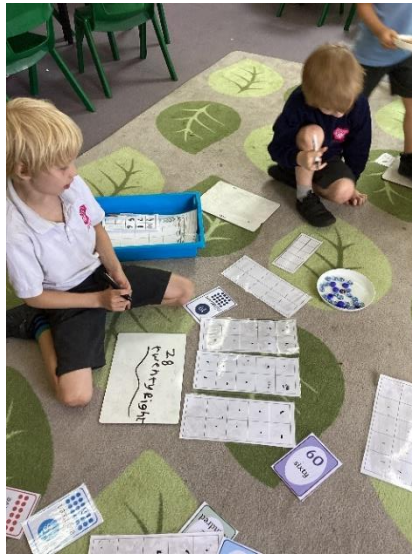
In maths we have been learning about place value, using a range of resources to support our learning.

Area in geography and exploring the art of local artist Yvonne Coomber.



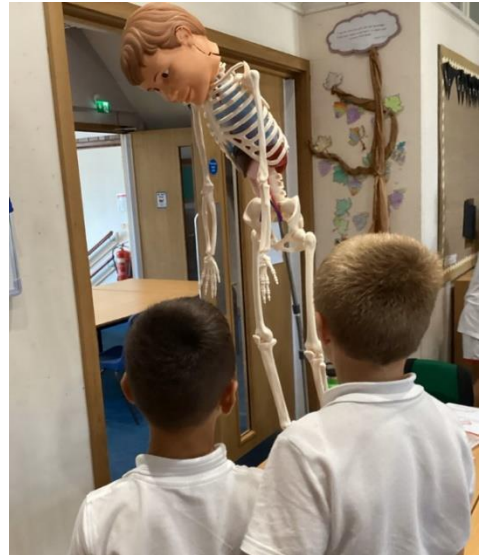
## Croft
